Senior Non-Clinical Career Establishment Research Fellowship in Cancer Imaging

University of Sheffield, UK

A career establishment fellowship for a non-clinician imaging scientist (e.g. MRI physicist) is proposed to develop research in the area of functional imaging of cancer with an initial focus on clinical applications in lung.

The research fellow will develop their own research and help secure larger grants within the established lung imaging / oncology activities. They will also contribute to developing new oncology imaging research activities that are of strategic importance to the faculty of medicine. The post will have some associated startup funding for the holder to develop their research.

The candidate will be based in Department of Oncology and the POLARIS MRI Research Group at the University of Sheffield. The group consists of physicists, engineers and clinicians working on the development and clinical evaluation of lung MR imaging techniques, our range of research is outlined at www.shef.ac.uk/polaris

Candidates should have a PhD and in imaging science (eg MRI physics) with a focus in oncology and some post doctoral or equivalent experience.
